





This government-backed loan program provides a practical way to fund your training, allowing you to focus on your studies without financial stress.




Consider a scenario where a student aspires to enter the airline industry and plans to complete the Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL), Multi-Engine Command Instrument Rating (MECIR), and Flight Instructor Rating (FIR) to gain the necessary experience for a direct entry officer position with one of the Australian airlines, based on the requirements listed on their website as of October 2023. Now, let's examine the timelines for both the diploma and bachelor pathways.

- 1.1 Years Achieved CPL, roughly 155 total flying hours
- 1.4 Years Achieved MECIR, roughly 210 total flying hours
- 1.7 Years Achieved Flight Instrument Rating (FIR), roughly 250 totally flying hours.
 Start working as a Grade 3 flight instructor
- 2.5 Years Upgrade to a Grade 2 Flight Instructor, roughly 500 total flying hours
- 3.5 years Upgrade to a Grade 1 Flight Instructor, roughly 1,000 - 1,100 total flying hours. Ready to teach night, multi-engine and instrument flying
- 4.5 years Ready to apply for airlines (The average for airline carriers in Australia)

- 3 Years Achieved CPL, MECIR, roughly 200 total flying hours
- 3.5 Years Achieved Flight Instrument Rating (FIR), roughly 250 totally flying hours. Start working as a Grade 3 flight instructor
- 4.3 Years Upgrade to a Grade 2 Flight Instructor, roughly 500 total flying hours
- 5 Years Still working as a Grade 2 Flight Instructor


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Flight Safety




